3.6.5. ~~Thirty seconds after the cars have been released into warm-up, pit exit will be closed.~~ Pit exit will close after 3 minutes have elapsed from Pit opening. Any cars that are late (fail to leave the pits before the first car approaches the starting grid line), shall start from the pit without doing a warm up lap, under the procedures established in these regulations. The Race Director and/or Clerk of the Course shall act as judge of fact in determining “lateness”.

3.11.2. Pitlane: The outer lane or lanes are to be kept unobstructed to allow safe passage of cars at all times. The onus shall be on all Drivers to take all due care and drive at minimum speeds in pit lanes. The designated Pitlane speed limit shall be 60km/h, unless stated otherwise through Official Instructions during the Driver’s Briefing.
